Departures Level:

 There are no work zones impacting Departures Level ground transportation the week of Sunday, August 26 through Saturday, September 1

Arrivals Level:

 Shared Ride Van Zone at Terminal 4 will be temporarily reduced Friday, August 31 through Monday, September 10. The impacted zone will be temporarily relocated to the adjacent area (east half of zone)

Continuous

- Construction barricades on the sidewalk will be in place for duration of work at each zone
- Detours will be in place to quide pedestrians

Nightly

- Portions of the curbside drop-off and pick-up lanes at work zones will be restricted
- Detours will be in place to guide pedestrian and vehicular traffic





