	The event is intended to provide Information, Education, & Motivation about LAX for the community.
	Invite speakers to talk on disabilities in relation to air travel. Example: issues, trends, the future of air travel and its impact on persons with disabilities.
	Concurrent sessions on LAWA construction and plans for the future
	Have booths representing, CBP, airport, TSA, Metro, Department on Disability, Wheelchair service companies, airlines, airport police, LAFD, Emergency Management, disability organizations, etc.
	Possible Theme: "Everybody come, Let's Fly" "Get on the Plane"
	2. Work with a university on a survey of travelers with disabilities at LAX. Use data to develop a report on Observations of LAX from the Disability Community for management. The report could be issued at the public event in October.
	3. Hold a forum on disability travel issues faced by persons with disabilities at LAX and in general. The result will be a committee report on the topic.
	4. Fill vacant positions. We currently have two community positions empty.
	 Work with airport police on a disability event similar to the one in the summer of 2017.
	 Sponsor a bimonthly "get acquainted tour" for persons with disabilities of the airport. This would give people with severe disabilities the opportunity to experience the airport environment.
