• The LAX Shuttle stop at Terminal 3 / Terminal B will be **closed** Friday, September 21 through Thursday, September 27.



• The FlyAway Shuttle stop at Terminal B will be **closed** Friday, September 14 through Thursday, September 20.



• The FlyAway Shuttle stop at Terminal 6 will be **closed** per the following: West half closed Tuesday, September 11 through Monday, September 17; East half closed Monday, September 10 through Tuesday, September 18.



 The Rental Car Shuttle stop at Terminal 7 will be closed Wednesday, September 12 through Wednesday, September 19.



• The Hotel Shuttle stop at Terminal 7 will be **closed** per the following: West half closed Wednesday, September 19 through Tuesday, September 25; East half closed Thursday, September 20 through Wednesday, September 26.

Continuous

- Construction barricades on the Arrivals Level Shuttle Stop zones will be in place for the duration of work at each area
- Detour signage will be in place to guide pedestrians to the next available shuttle stop
- Detour signage will be in place to guide Ground Transportation providers / shuttle operators to the next available shuttle stop

Nightly

 Portions of the Shuttle Pick-Up / Drop-Off Lane adjacent to the Shuttle Stop zones will be restricted at each work area


