CTA ROADWAY IMPACTS Terminal 5.5 APM Pedestrian Bridge Construction

Monday, April 11 through Tuesday, May 24, 2022 Varying times between 10PM and 7AM

ACTIVITY

The Automated People Mover project will construct a new Pedestrian Bridge over the roadways between Terminals 5 and 6 to connect the APM's Center CTA Station with the Terminal 5.5 Vertical Core. Construction requires various nightly lane restrictions and / or full closures on World Way South at Terminal 5.5 between Monday, April 11 and Tuesday, May 24, 2022.

Nightly full closures of Arrivals Level Outer Lanes are scheduled for *Monday, April 11 through Wednesday, April 27 and overnight Monday, May 23 to Tuesday, May 24. Nightly full closures of all Departures Level lanes are scheduled for *Tuesday, April 19 through Wednesday, April 27.

*Please note: No nightly closures will be implemented on Friday or Saturday nights, meaning no closures the nights of Friday, April 15, Saturday, April 16, Friday, April 22 and Saturday, April 23.

Detours for shuttle operations, vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be implemented as needed. Signage and flaggers will be in place to assist with wayfinding, including directing pedestrians to alternate shuttle stops and crosswalks when existing stops or pedestrian routes are closed or relocated.

Work will occur during limited overnight hours. Additional notifications will be issued with more details for scheduled closures on both levels and related Ground Transportation impacts. Please watch for signage and prepare to follow detour routes. Use caution when traveling through construction areas.
